20.0 Child restraint laws

Babies aged 0 to six months must be secured in an approved rearward facing baby capsule or infant restraint that is properly fastened and adjusted. As the Club Courtesy buses do not have approved restraint buckles, babies are not permitted to travel in the buses

Babies and children aged between six months and four years of age must be secured in either an approved rearward facing child restraint or an approved forward facing child restraint with built-in harness that is properly fastened and adjusted. It is recommended that a baby remain in an approved infant restraint for as long as possible. As the Club Courtesy buses do not have approved restraint buckles, babies & children are not permitted to travel in the buses

Children who have reached four years of age must be secured in an approved booster seat with a H-harness or a booster seat with a secured adult lap/sash seatbelt that is properly fastened and adjusted. The child must be secured in this manner up until they turn 7 yrs of age. *It is the responsibility of the parent to provide an approved seat for children travelling in the courtesy buses.*
