



## Facial Recognition Data Collection Policy for Bribie Island RSL & Citizens Memorial Club Inc.

### Relevant legislation:

Privacy Act 1988 (Cth), the Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld), and Queensland gambling legislation.

---

### Purpose

Bribie Island RSL & Citizens Memorial Club Inc (“the Club”) uses facial recognition technology to support a safe and responsible environment for all members, guests and staff.

This technology assists in identifying patrons who are subject to **banning orders, self-exclusions or exclusions under the Gambling Act 1991 (Qld)**, and to meet the Club’s obligations under **Queensland gambling harm minimisation laws**.

### Scope

This policy applies to all persons entering the Club’s premises, including members, guests, visitors, contractors and employees.

---

### Collection of Images

When you enter the Club, cameras using facial recognition software may capture and temporarily process your image.

Your image is collected solely for the purpose of identifying banned or excluded persons and for maintaining the safety and security of patrons and staff.

---

### Use of Collected Information

Facial images and related data are used only to:

- Identify patrons subject to exclusion or banning orders;
- Assist authorised Club staff to meet their legal and regulatory obligations; and
- Support venue security and incident investigation when required by law.

The Club does **not** use facial recognition data for marketing, membership tracking, or any unrelated purpose.

---

### Storage and Retention

- Images of non-excluded patrons are automatically deleted within 48 hours (or sooner where practicable).
- Images of identified excluded or banned persons may be securely retained for the duration of the exclusion or as required by law.

- All data is stored in secure, access-controlled systems within Australia.
- 

### **Access and Disclosure**

Access to facial recognition data is restricted to authorised personnel and may be disclosed only to:

- The Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation (OLGR);
- Queensland Police Service; or
- Other authorities where required by law.

The Club does not share, sell or transfer data to any third party for commercial purposes.

---

### **Your Rights**

Patrons may request:

- Access to information held about them;
- Correction of any inaccurate information; or
- Deletion of their data where appropriate.
