



Bribie Island RSL Courtesy Bus – Code of Conduct

Bribie Island RSL provides a Courtesy Bus for our members, their guests, and visitors travelling to and from the Club within our designated service zone. Please refer to the Courtesy Bus map or check with Reception to confirm that your pick-up/drop-off location is within this zone.

Conditions of Use

1. **Courtesy Service** – The Courtesy Bus is provided by Bribie Island RSL for members, members' guests, and visitors to the Club. It is not a public transport service.
2. **Membership Expectation** – Regular users of this service are expected to be financial members of Bribie Island RSL.
3. **Capacity & Safety** – The bus carries a maximum of 11 passengers. Seatbelts must be always worn by all passengers.
4. **CCTV Monitoring** – CCTV operates on the bus for the safety and security of passengers and drivers.
5. **Travel Zone** – Pick-up and drop-off must be within the designated zone. Destinations outside of this area are at the discretion of the Courtesy Bus driver in consultation with the General Manager.
6. **Residential Address Requirement** - The Courtesy Bus service is strictly limited to the residential address recorded on the member's current membership account. Drivers must only pick up and drop off members at this address. Pick-ups or drop-offs at any other location including other licensed venues, private residences, commercial premises, or public places are strictly prohibited. There are no exceptions to this requirement.

Note: If patron is staying at an Accommodation house, Caravan Park, Air B & B, this address becomes their residential address for the purpose of pick-up and drop offs.

7. **No Food, Alcohol or Smoking** – Smoking, vaping, and the consumption of food or alcohol are not permitted on the bus.
8. **Behaviour Standards** – Offensive language, disruptive behaviour, or failure to comply with the driver's directions may result in removal from the bus and refusal of future travel.
9. **Driver's Authority** – The driver determines the order of pick-up and drop-off. This decision is final and not open to dispute.
10. **Age Restrictions** – Passengers under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

11. Child Restraint Laws –

- **Babies aged 0 to six months** must be secured in an approved rearward facing baby capsule or infant restraint that is properly fastened and adjusted. As the Club Courtesy buses do not have approved restraint buckles, babies are not permitted to travel in the buses.
- **Babies and children** aged between six months, and four years of age must be secured in either an approved rearward facing child restraint or an approved forward facing child restraint with built-in harness that is properly fastened and adjusted. It is recommended that a baby remain in an approved infant restraint for as long as possible. As the Club Courtesy buses do not have approved restraint buckles, babies & children are not permitted to travel in the buses.
- **Children** who have reached four years of age must be secured in an approved booster seat with a H-harness or a booster seat with a secured adult lap/sash seatbelt that is properly fastened and adjusted. The child must be secured in this manner up until they turn 7 yrs of age. It is the responsibility of the parent to provide an approved seat for children travelling in the courtesy buses.

11. **Respect for Others** – Please always be courteous to the driver and fellow passengers.

12. **Dress & Behaviour** – Bribie Island RSL's dress and behaviour standards apply when using the Courtesy Bus.

13. **On-Demand Service** – The Courtesy Bus operates on demand during allocated service times. Passengers can request pick-up when they are ready to travel.

14. **Estimated Times** – Pick-up and drop-off times are approximate only and may vary depending on demand and traffic conditions.
